ORDINANCE NO. A - 20 /

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING AND FIXING LICENSES FOR ENGAGING IN CERTAIN TRADE, BUSINESSES, OCCUPATIONS, VOCATIONS AND PROFESSIONS IN THE CITY OF CROSSETT, ARKANSAS, FIXING THE RATE OF FEES FOR LICENSES, THE PENALTIES FOR NON PAYMENT, THE TIME FOR PAYMENT; TO REPEAL EXISTING ORDINANCES ON THE SAME SUBJECT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROSSETT, ARKANSAS:

SECTION I.

Except as hereinafter specifically provided, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to engage in, follow, or conduct any of the businesses, trades, occupations, vocations, or professions hereinafter listed in this ordinance within the City of Crossett without having first paid the license fee and obtained a license from the City Clerk in accordance with the Occupation Tax Rate Schedule hereinafter set forth.

SECTION II.

No license or fee under this ordinance shall be required to be paid by any organization which is principally composed of local citizens and is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, civic or other eleomonsonary purposes, in connection with the conduct of any trade or business for which a license would otherwise be required if such trade or business is not carried on regularly, from day to day, but is casual or occasional only.

SECTION III.

If two or more businesses, trades, occupations, vocations or professions are being conducted from one premise, whether or not operated under the same name, if the ownership or operation thereof, is by the same or substantially the same persons, firms or corporation, the license tax shall be paid according to the highest applicable rate on only one such business, trade, occupation, vocation or profession.

SECTION IV.

There is hereby levied upon the conduct in the City of Crossett of the businesses, trades, occupations, vocations and professions hereinafter listed an Occupation License Fee Tax in accordance with the following Occupation Tax Rate Schedule:

RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS: All business establishments where the primary business is sale of merchandise at retail, upless a specific rate is otherwise provided in this Ordinance, shall be taxed in accordance with the following schedule of retail taxes unless there is otherwise provided in this ordinance a specific tax upon the kind of business being so conducted. If two (2) retail businesses are being conducted from one premise, whether or not operated under the same name, if the ownership or operation thereof is by the same or substantially the same persons, firm or corporation, the tax shall be paid according to the highest applicable rate on only one such business. Each business whose tax is based upon a square foot charge shall permit the City Clerk, or his representative, free access to the premises at any time for purpose of determining the area used by each business. In computing per square foot tax rates, all area normally used by such business, including all storage and display area whether or not enclosed and whether or not under roof shall be included.

Each business whose tax is based upon average number of employees, shall during the month of January each year certify to the City Clerk the average number of employees on its payroll for the preceding 12 month period.

All taxes due under this Ordinance shall be paid on or before January 31st each year, or within thirty days after commencing operation, and any tax not so paid shall be considered delinquent and a 10% penalty shall promptly attach and in addition the person redsponsible therefor shall be liable for all costs incurred in any proceeding for collection, including a reasonable attorney's fee and suit shall be instituted by the City Clerk on behalf of the City of Crossett for collection in any Court of proper venue having jurisdiction of the amount of delinquent tax and penalty and in addition an injunction may be sought to enjoin the continued operation of such business until the delinquent tax, penalty, costs and attorney's fee shall be fully paid.

Any business or occupation not in operation on the first day of the calendar year shall pay its tax pro rated by quarters, according to the number of full calendar quarters remaining in the calendar year during which the business is commenced.

SECTION V.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances except Ordinance
No. A-102 and Ordinance No. A-17 as amended, which are in conflict
herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI.

It is hereby found that many occupations, businesses, trades and professions are currently being conducted for which no tax is presently provided and that many discrepancies currently exist in the rate and method of levy of occupation taxes resulting in many inequities and much loss of revenue to the City; and that many itinerant persons are conducting trades, businesses and occupations within the City without proper police regulation and in competition with local businesses without paying any taxes on account thereof thus resulting in unfair competition and that the enactment of this ordinance is necessary for the protection and welfare of the citizens of Crossett, Arkansas, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption and publication, and the rates of license tax herein provided shall be effective for the year 1962.
